<b>Job responsibilities</b>	As part of a project by the Japan Agency for Medical Research and Development (AMED), we are engaged in spatial transcriptomics data analysis and the development of analytical methods. Our project involves the collection, processing, and analysis of large-scale spatial transcriptomics data. We are seeking researchers in bioinformatics and computational biology with experience in single-cell or spatial transcriptomics data analysis.
